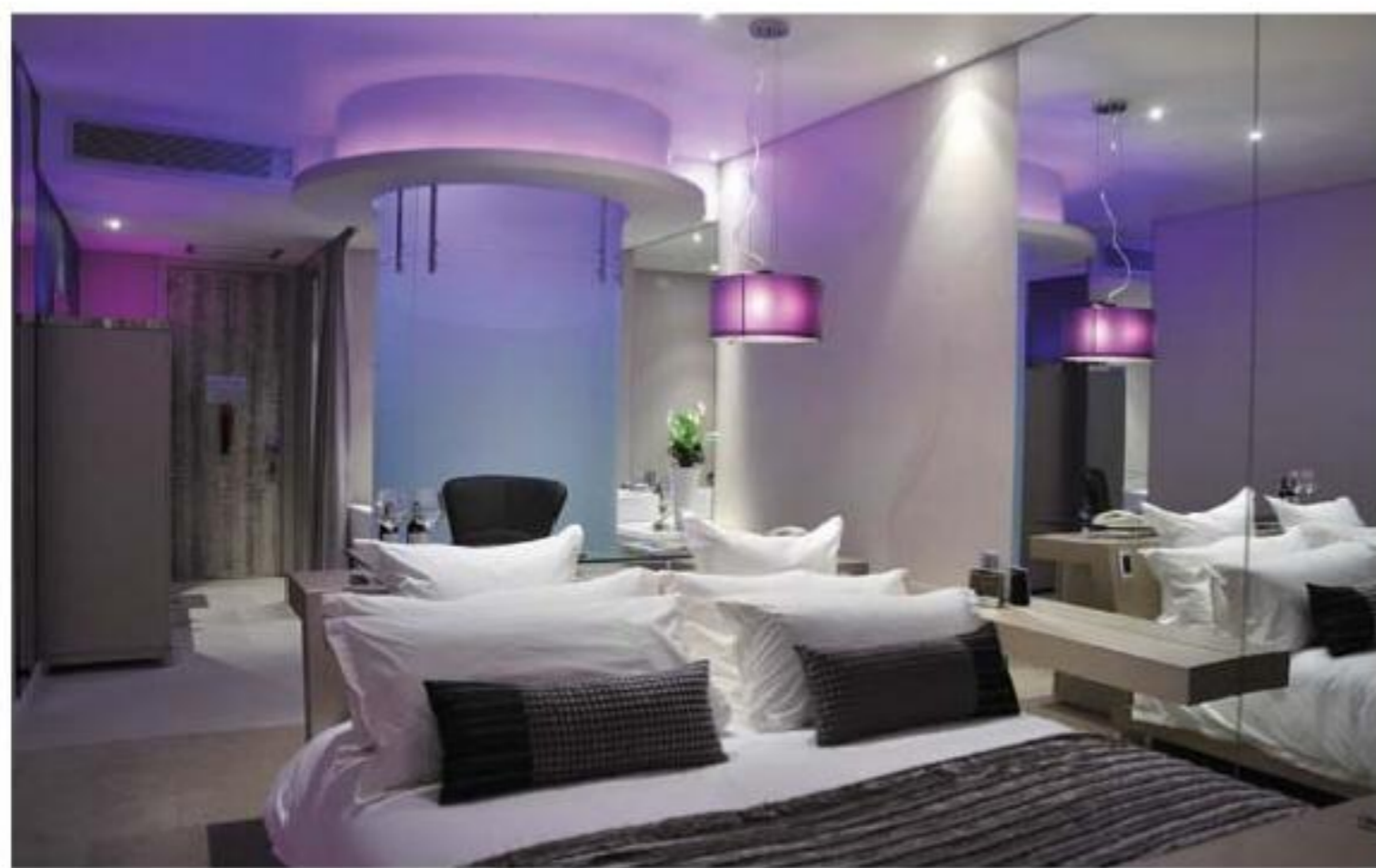




# 5-star hotel safari
